SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Jurisdiction: Held under the National Sporting Code of the ACU; the standing Trials Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions that may be issued for the meeting.

Classes: Expert, Intermediates, Novice, Over 40, Over 50, Twinshock, Air cooled Mono, Pre 67 Red, Pre 67 Yellow, Modern Sidecar, Sportsperson, Youth Expert, Youth intermediate, Youth Novice, Youth Beginner.

Routes: White Route - Adult and Youth Experts.
Blue Route - Adult and Youth Inters and Over 40.
Red Route - Adult and Youth Novices, Over 50, Air cooled Mono, Twinshock, Pre 67 (Red) and Sidecars.
Yellow Route - Sportsperson, Pre 67 (Yellow) and Youth Beginner.

Advance Entry: £15 for Solos, £20 for Sidecars, and £10 for Youths.

Entry on the Day: £25 for Solos, £30 for Sidecars, and £15 for Youths.

Course: 4 laps of 10 sections.

Child Protection: The secretary of the meeting is the point of contact.

Signing on: All entrants riding must show their club membership and ACU Licence details when signing on at the event. NO ACU QR Code = Day Licence Purchase £15. No ACU Club = £1 Day Membership to Croydon MCC

Medication: It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs; you may be tested. Having entered the event, if you become a non starter you must explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the Rules.
